NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT REVIEW

This notice serves as an opportunity to comment on the application described below.

Proposal: The Columbia River Gorge Commission has received an application from Don Cannard of the Chinook Trail Association, representing Nancy Russell, to re-route a majority of the Cherry Orchard Trail. The re-route would change the current 30% grade to one that ranges between an 8% and 16%. The renovation would include run off provisions to prevent future erosion and the potential removal of an existing barbed wire fence. The altered trail would measure 28 inches wide and soil displacement would be a total of 85 cubic yards of grading. As proposed, the re-routed trail would consist of approximately 4,500 linear feet.

Location: The existing trail traverses several parcels located just east of Lyle, Washington. The proposed enhancements would be occurring on two contiguously owned parcels; numbers 02-12-1200-0005/00 and 02-12-0200-0010/00 in the SW 1/4 of Section 2, Township 2 North, Range 12 East, W.M., Klickitat County, Washington.

Zoning: Both parcels are designated GMA A-2 (160) Small-Scale Agriculture


Deadline: The deadline for submitting public comment on the proposal is March 25, 2008.

The Executive Director is scheduled to make a decision on the request by May 15, 2008.
