## COLUMBIA RIVER GORGE COMMISSION

### REVISED NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT REVIEW

This notice serves as an opportunity to comment on the application described below.  
***The comment period has been extended for this application because the applicant revised the development proposal.***

**Proposal:** The Columbia River Gorge Commission has received an application from Marc Dinnerstein to remove an existing single-family dwelling and fill in the existing septic tank. The applicant also proposes to convert the existing garage into a living quarters and install a new septic system.

**Location:** The subject parcel is located 19 Balch Road, approximately 2 miles west of Lyle, in the SW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 3 North, Range 12 East, W.M., Klickitat County, Washington.

**Case File:** C08-0016-K-G-19

**Zoning:** The subject parcel is designated Small-Scale Agriculture (A-2) and is 126 acres in size.

**Deadline:** The deadline for submitting public comment on the proposal is July 29, 2008.

The application is also subject to review for consistency with the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area Act (P.L. 99-663) and Management Plan. Consistency with the National Scenic Area Act does not imply nor ensure compliance with all other applicable local, state, and federal laws.

The Executive Director is scheduled to make a decision on the request by September 18, 2008.

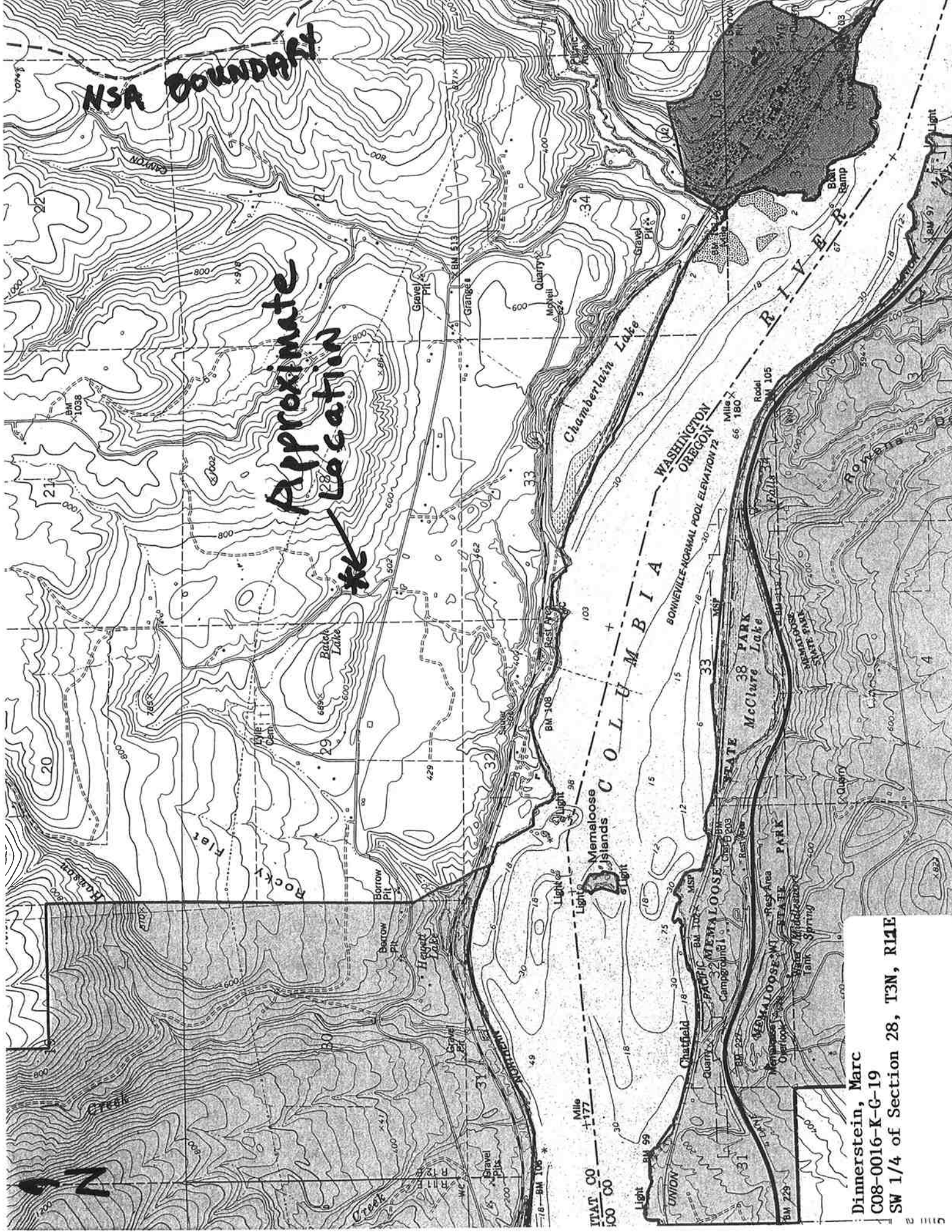
