NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT REVIEW

This notice serves as an opportunity to comment on the application described below.

Proposal: The Columbia River Gorge Commission has received an application from Jim McColgin and LuAnne Stevens to cultivate a new 0.64 acre vineyard, install above ground drip irrigation, an associated three-wire trellis system and deer fencing to enclose the vineyard and wire-strand livestock fencing to enclose the western half of the parcel.

Location: The subject parcel is located at 167 Lyle-Snowden Road in the SE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 3 North, Range 12 East, W.M., Klickitat County, Washington.

Case File: C08-0019-K-G-22

Zoning: The subject parcel is designated Small-Scale Agriculture and is 10.98 acres in size.


Deadline: The deadline for submitting public comment on the proposal is September 5, 2008.

Consistency with the National Scenic Area Act does not imply nor ensure compliance with all other applicable local, state, and federal laws.

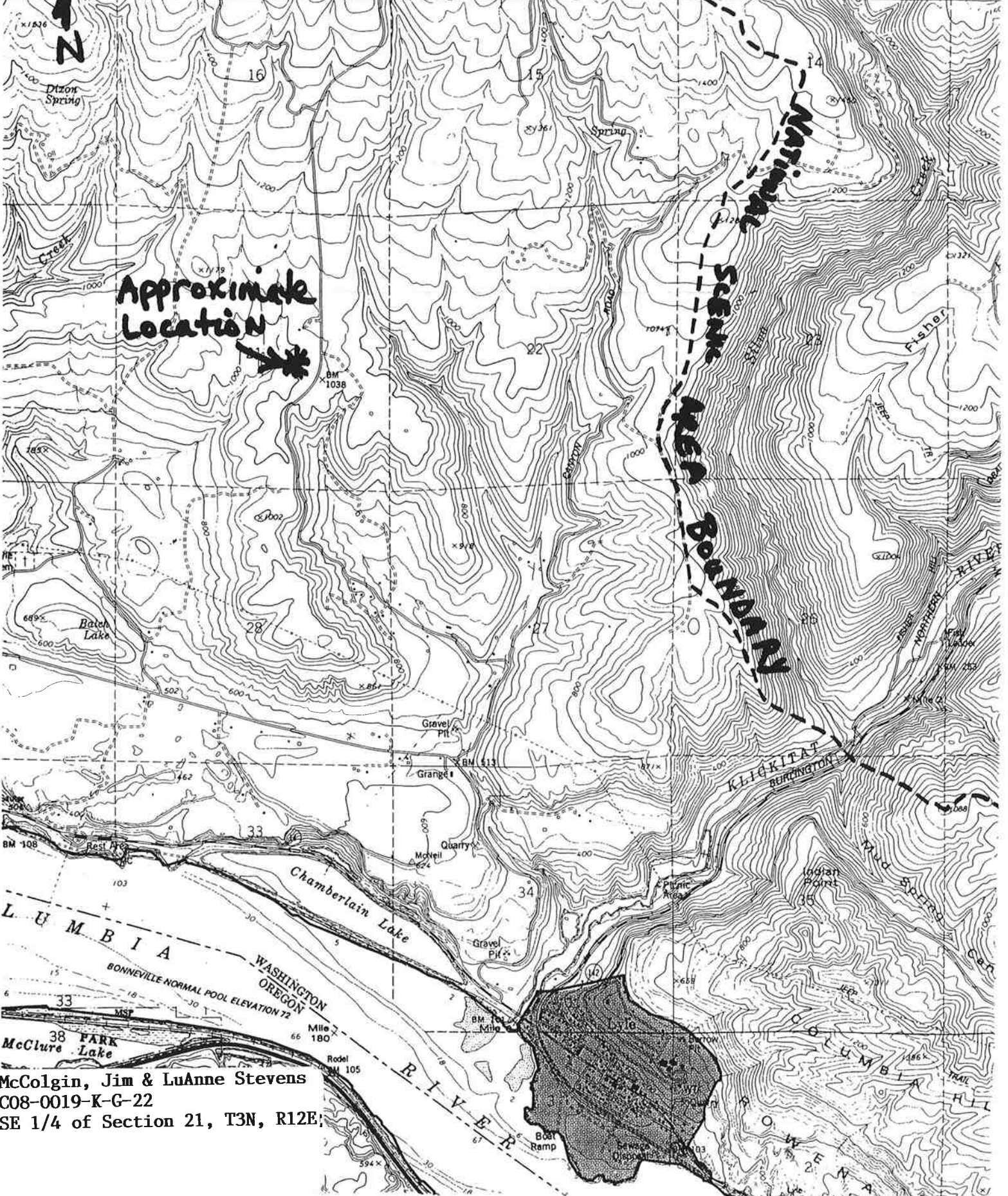
The Executive Director is scheduled to make a decision on the request by October 26, 2008.
