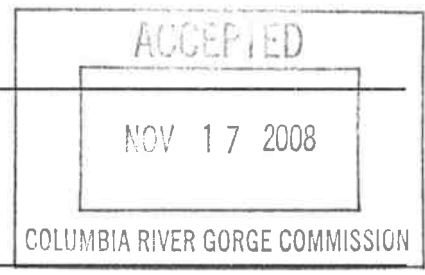

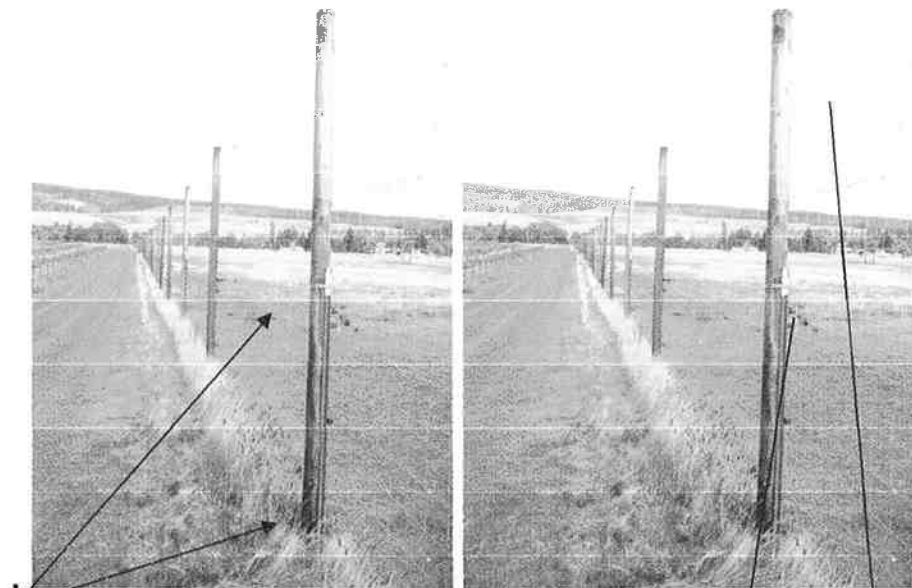

### Fence improvement.

The existing fence was approx. 4 feet high with t-posts 15-20 feet apart. I extended the existing t-posts by strapping 4 inch, untreated wood posts to the existing t-posts. The ground was not disturbed. Woven wire fence was extended above the existing wire fence to a height of 7 Feet high. See pictures below.

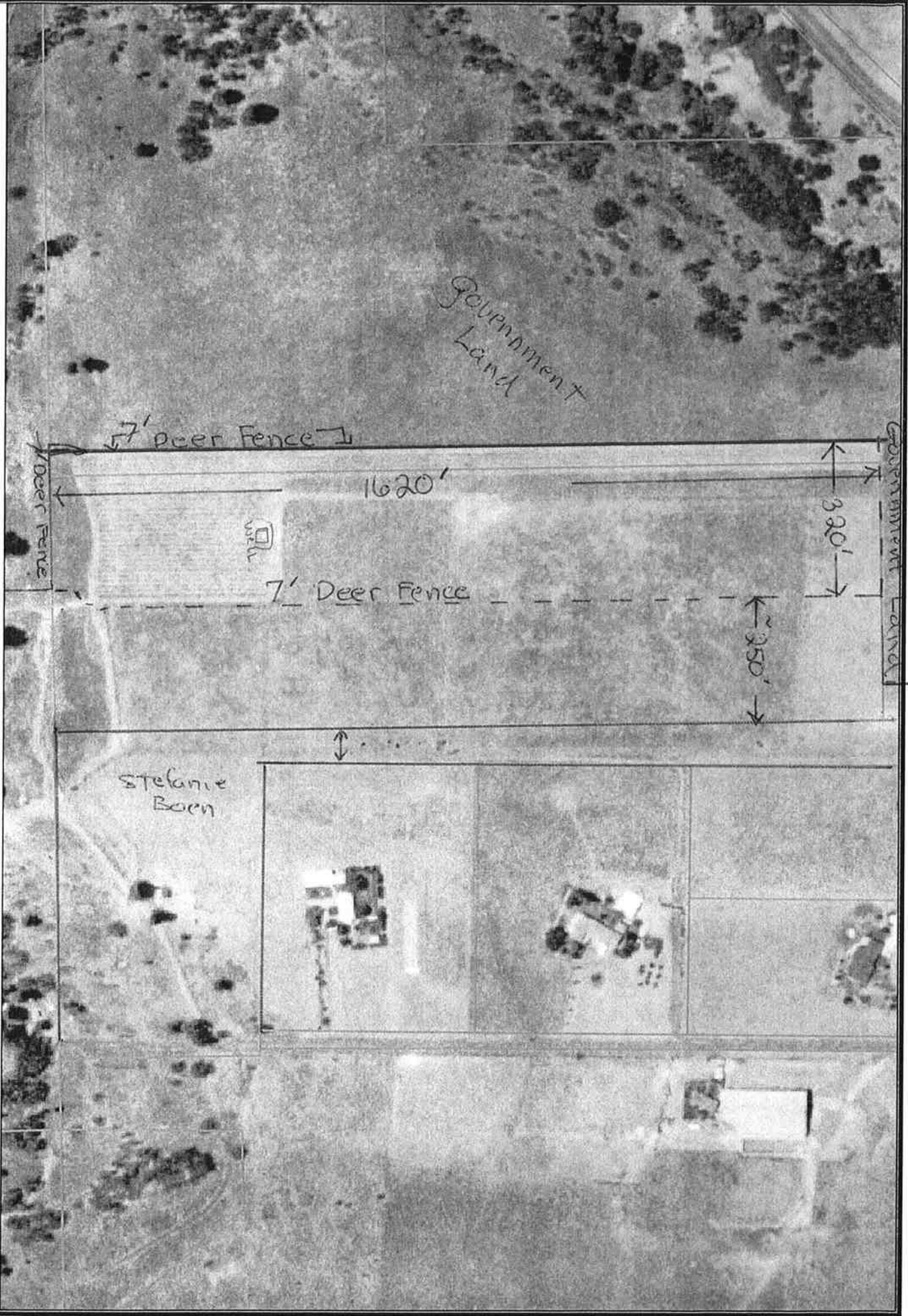
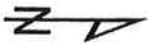


Strapping, holding wooden-posts to t-posts
