### NOTICE OF REVIEW OF EMERGENCY/DISASTER RESPONSE ACTION

This notice serves as an opportunity to comment on the application described below.

**Proposal:** The Columbia River Gorge Commission has received an after-the-fact application from the Klickitat County Public Works Department to review emergency/disaster response actions taken in response to a rockslide on Old Highway 8. The actions taken by KPWD include scaling of loose rock, the installation of rock bolts to secure larger blocks that could not be removed and the removal of the fallen material.

**Location:** The subject parcel is located near the intersection of Old Highway 8 and State Route 14, about five miles west of Lyle, WA. It is located in the NW ¼ of Section 35, Township 3 North, Range 11 East, W.M., Klickitat County, Washington.

**Case File:** C09-0002-K-S-23

**Zoning:** The subject parcel is designated Special Management Open Space and is 19.55 acres in size

Consistency with the National Scenic Area Act does not imply nor ensure compliance with all other applicable local, state, and federal laws.

The Executive Director is scheduled to make a decision on the request by May 2, 2009.
