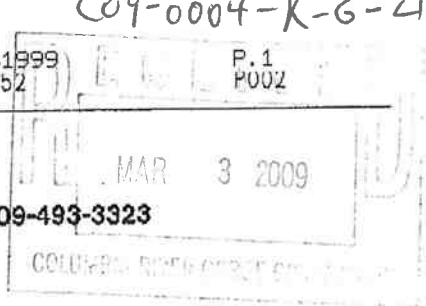

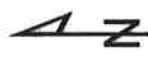

Project description: Describe your proposed project including details on all uses proposed; the size, height, color, and construction materials of all structures; and any other details which explain how your proposal meets the requirements of the Scenic Area Land Use Ordinance.

Construct, operate and maintain a 25 pair buried telephone communication cable on the north side of Power House Road from the intersection of Forester Lane for approximately 2200' to the boat launch access road. Then crossing under Power House Road to the east side and continuing on for approximately 2300'. This work activity will also place 7 pedestals approximately 8" in diameter and 30" high along the cable route for splice points and access to the buried cable. This work is necessary to provide telephone service for two existing customers and for one additional customer at 88 Power House. This work will also retire in place an existing 25 pair buried cable from Highway 141 to the intersection of Forester Lane on Power House Road.
