NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT REVIEW

This notice serves as an opportunity to comment on the application described below.

Proposal: The Columbia River Gorge Commission has received an application from Otak, Inc., representing Washington State Parks and Recreation, to construct a parking lot near the existing trailhead for Horsethief Butte, including installation of a vault toilet, signage, entrance and exit gates, and construction of a new trail leading from the facility to the existing trail.

Location: The project is located at Columbia Hills State Park, approximately 3 miles east of the SR 14 and Highway 197 intersection in Dallesport, WA. The parcel is located within the NE 1/4 of Section 19 and the SW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 2 North, Range 14 East, W.M., Klickitat County, Washington.

Zoning: The project area is designated Open Space.


Deadline: The deadline for submitting public comment on the proposal is July 10, 2009.

This application will be reviewed for consistency with the applicable portions of the Land Use Ordinance adopted by the Columbia River Gorge Commission (Commission Rule 350-81). The application is also subject to review for consistency with the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area Act (P.L. 99-663) and Management Plan. Consistency with the National Scenic Area Act does not imply nor ensure compliance with all other applicable local, state, and federal laws.

The Executive Director is scheduled to make a decision on the request by August 29, 2009.
