NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT REVIEW

This notice serves as an opportunity to comment on the application described below.


- Proposal:** The Columbia River Gorge Commission has received an application from the Public Utility District No. 1 of Klickitat County to modify an existing power line, including the installation of three new poles (38' 6" high) and the replacement of seven single poles with double poles (43' high).
- Location:** The project is located to the northwest of Lyle, WA, within a utility easement running approximately 10,000 linear feet from the intersection of Canyon Road with Pitman Road to the Lyle Falls Fishway Project on the west bank of the Klickitat River. The easement is in the N 1/2 of Section 34, NW ¼ of Section 35, and the S ½ of Section 26, Township 3 North, Range 12 East, W.M., Klickitat County, Washington.
- Case File:** C09-0014
- Zoning:** The easement runs through lands designated Small-scale Agriculture at the west end to Large-scale Agriculture over the eastern portions of the line.
- Comment Deadline:** The deadline for submitting public comment on the proposal is November 10, 2009.

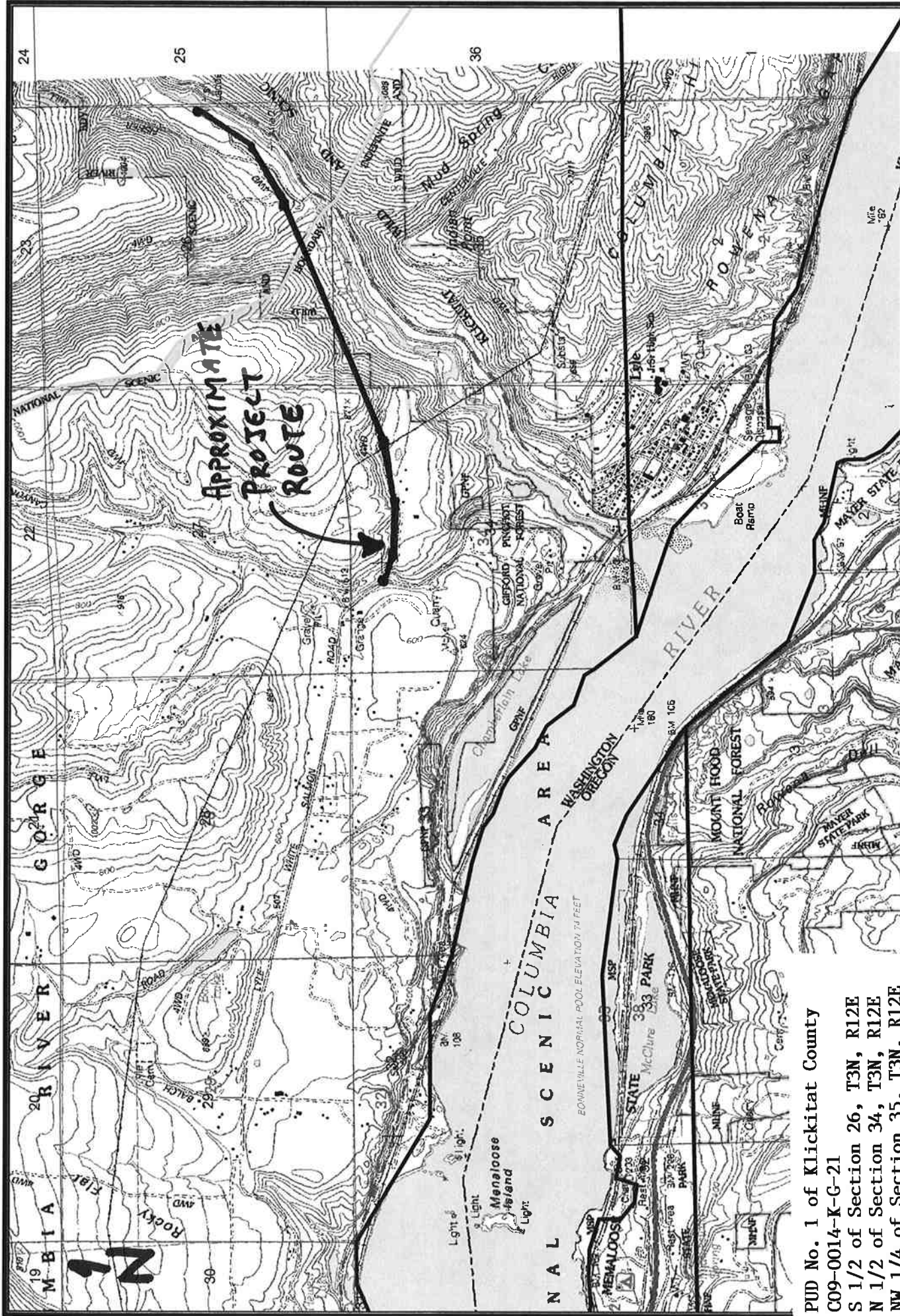

Consistency with the National Scenic Area Act does not imply nor ensure compliance with all other applicable local, state, and federal laws.

The Executive Director is scheduled to make a decision on the request by December 31, 2009.
