REVISED NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT REVIEW


This notice serves as an opportunity to comment on the application described below. The project description has been revised from the original notice.

- Proposal:** The Columbia River Gorge Commission has received an application from Peter and Therese Leon to replace an existing mobile home with a 4944 square foot new dwelling, construct a 48' x 40' agricultural building, board horses, install and repair fencing, and install utility lines to support the proposed development.
- Location:** The subject parcel is located approximately 3 miles west of Wishram, north of Highway 14 in the NE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 2 North, Range 14 East, W.M., Klickitat County, Washington.
- Case File:** C10-0001-K-G-11
- Zoning:** The subject parcel is designated Large-Scale Agriculture and is 40.2 acres in size.
- Comment Deadline:** The deadline for submitting public comment on the proposal is March 4, 2010.

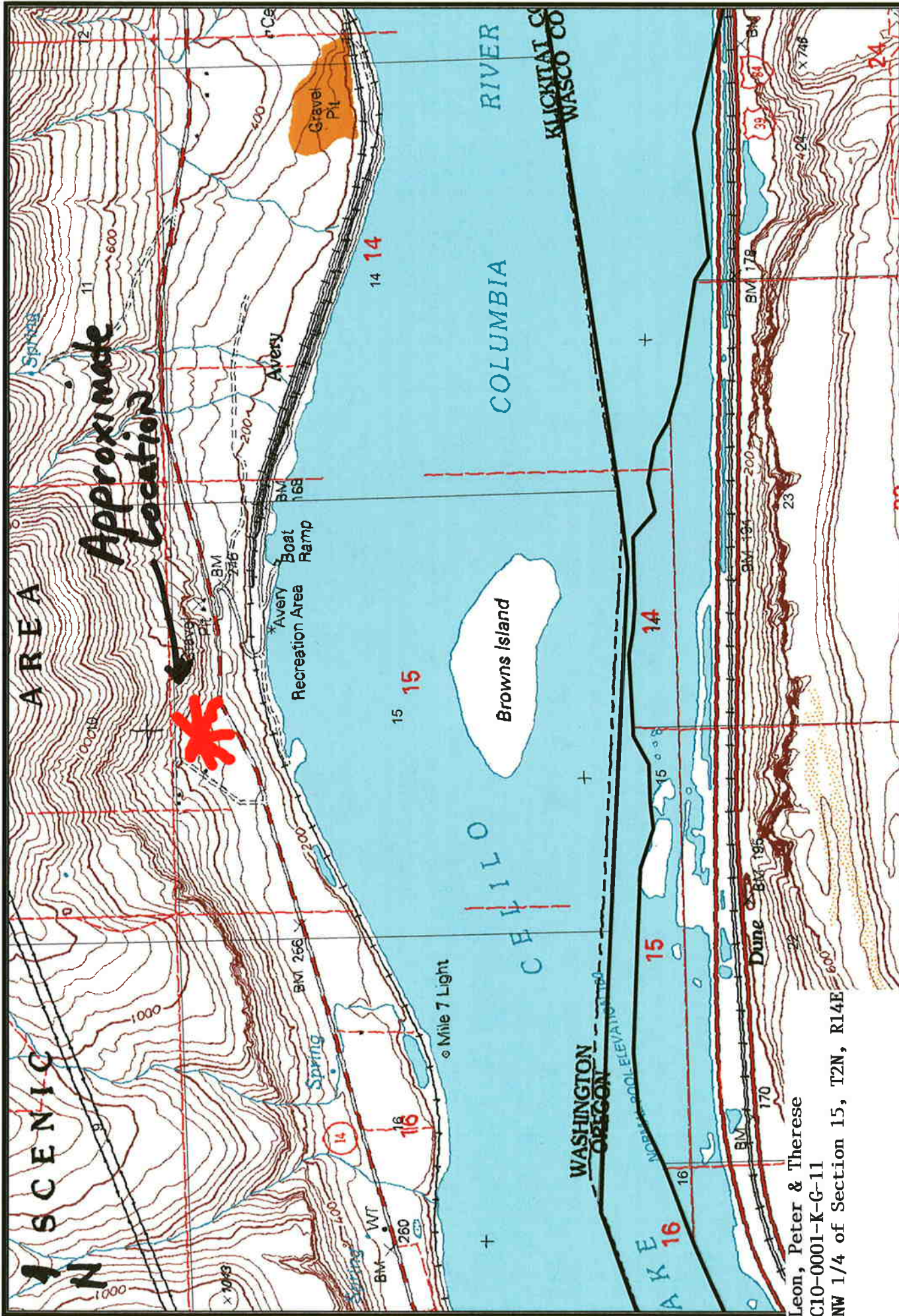

The application is also subject to review for consistency with the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area Act (P.L. 99-663) and Management Plan. Consistency with the National Scenic Area Act does not imply nor ensure compliance with all other applicable local, state, and federal laws.

The Executive Director is scheduled to make a decision on the request by April 22, 2010.
