NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT REVIEW

This notice serves as an opportunity to comment on the application described below.

- Proposal:** The Columbia River Gorge Commission has received an application from John and Joe Schreiner to construct a 1932 square foot giraffe barn, and to construct two segments of woven wire fencing (12 feet and 15 feet in length, both 9.5 feet in height). *Note: This application replaces a prior application for an addition to an existing giraffe barn that was withdrawn by the applicant (C10-0003-K-G-17).*

- Landowner:** John and Joe Schreiner
- Location:** The subject parcel is located on Schreiner Farms Road in Dallesport in the eastern ½ of Section 16, Township 2 North, Range 13 East, W.M., Klickitat County, Washington.
- Case File:** C10-0007-K-G-17
- Zoning:** The subject parcel is designated Large-Scale Agriculture and is 303.06 acres.
- Comment Deadline:** The deadline for submitting public comment on the proposal is July 19, 2010.

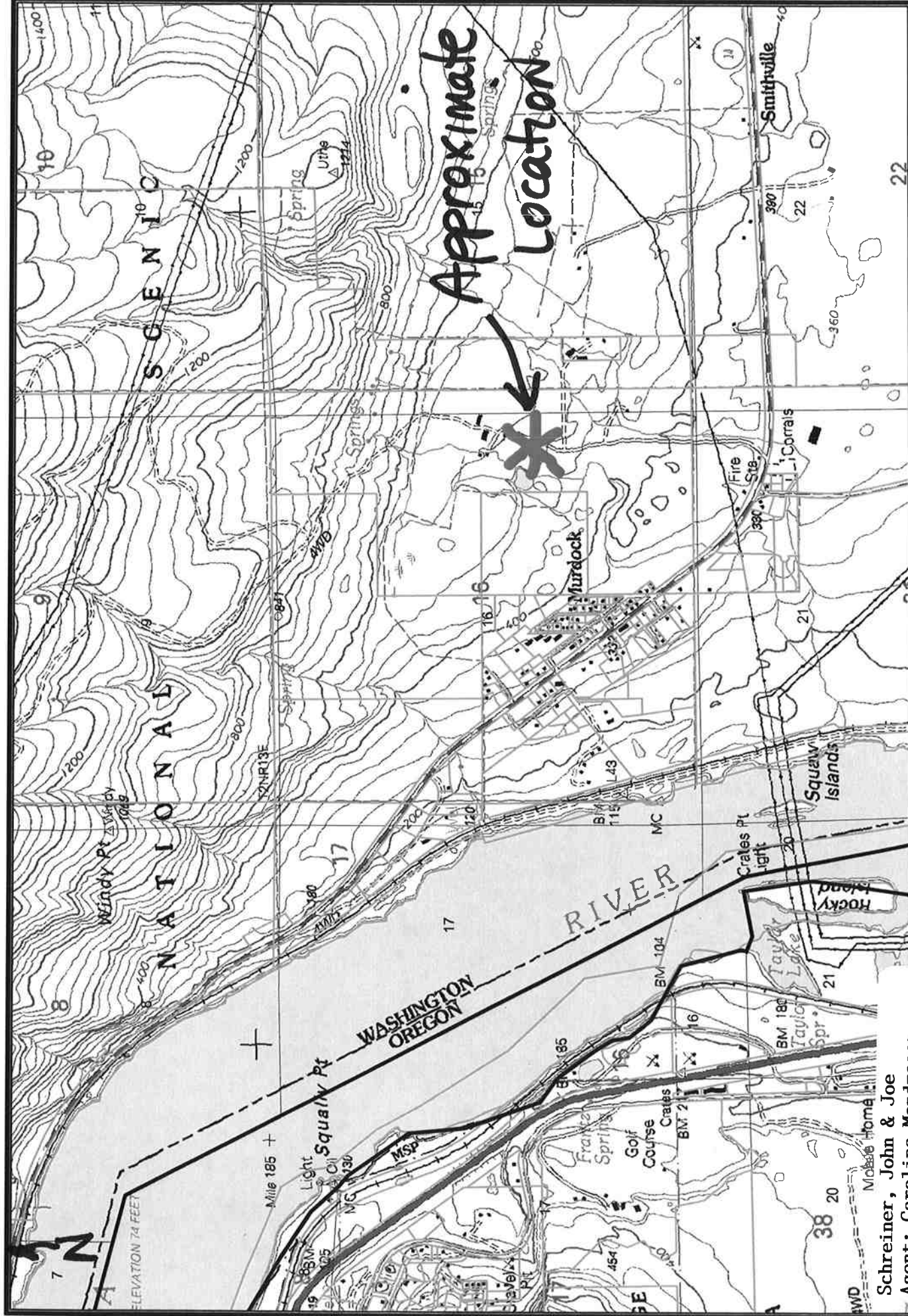

The Executive Director is scheduled to make a decision on the request by September 8, 2010.
