NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT REVIEW

This notice serves as an opportunity to comment on the application described below.

- Proposal:** The Columbia River Gorge Commission has received an application from the Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission to disassemble and reconstruct the historic Brune cabin at Columbia Hills State Park.
- Location:** The project is located on a portion of the park north of the Dalles Mountain Ranch in the SE 1/4 of Section 6, Township 2 North, Range 14 East, W.M., Klickitat County, Washington (Klickitat County Assessor's ID 0214060000200).
- Case File:** C11-0005
- Zoning:** The subject property is designated Large-Scale Agriculture. The Columbia Hills State Park is approximately 3,626 acres in size.
- Comment Deadline:** The deadline for submitting public comment on the proposal is April 20, 2011.

The application and supporting documents are available for review at the Commission's office at #1 Town & Country Square (next to the White Salmon library), White Salmon, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday. This application will be reviewed for consistency with the applicable portions of the Land Use Ordinance adopted by the Columbia River Gorge Commission (Commission Rule 350-81). The application is also subject to review for consistency with the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area Act (P.L. 99-663) and Management Plan. Consistency with the National Scenic Area Act does not imply nor ensure compliance with all other applicable local, state, and federal laws.

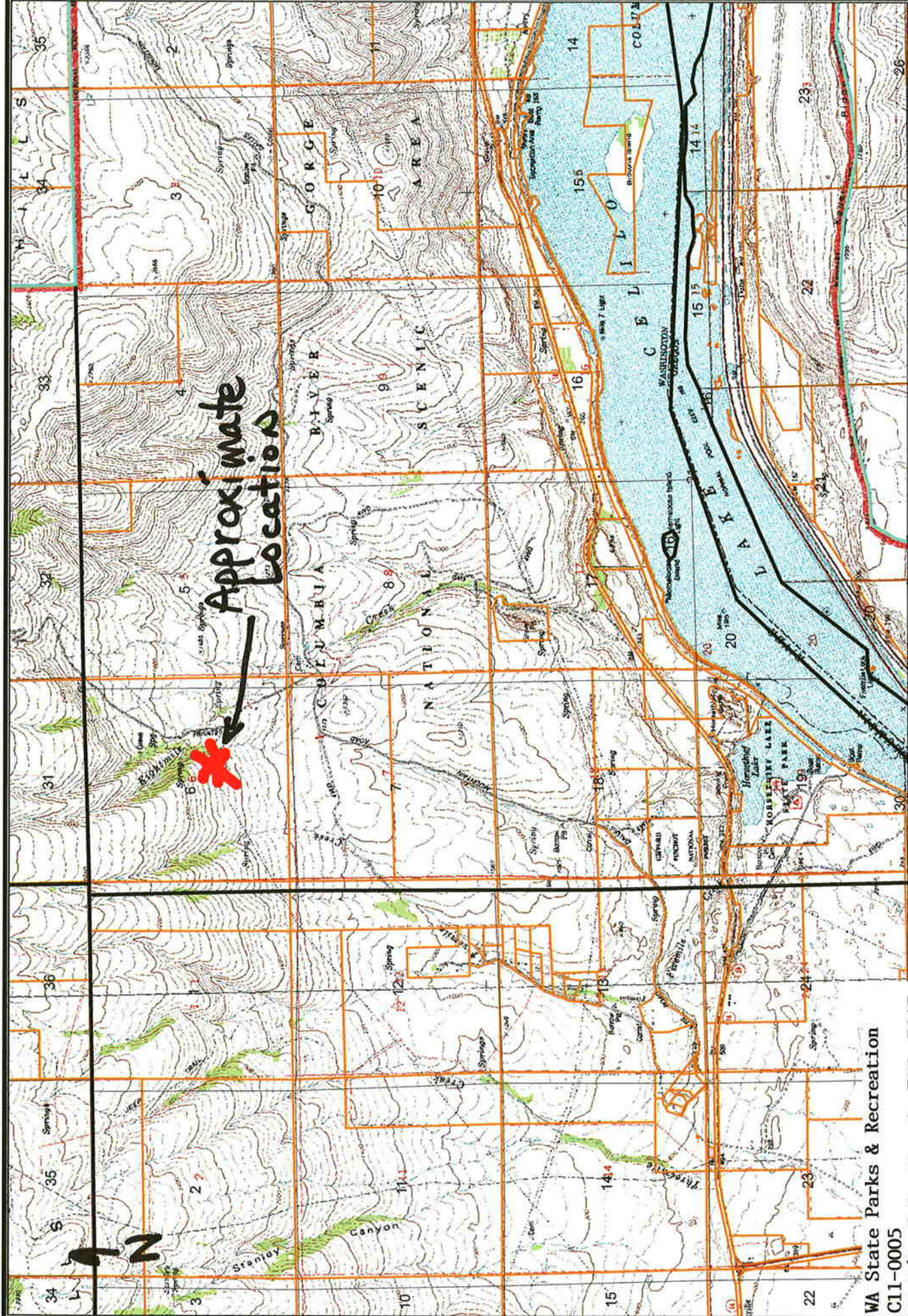
The Executive Director is scheduled to make a decision on the request by June 9, 2011.
