I sent you an email last webinar, but I was too late. Will you be submitting info from the last session, to the CRGC? I am a 30 year gorge resident and witness to continuous unplanned, unpermitted, un-inspected construction and radical changes to the natural landscape. I recently reported three gross NSA violations that Skamania County is ignoring. I have not received many

updates regarding these issues, but did get an email from Aiden Forsi regarding a couple of the issues, (no follow-up.) The reported rerouting of a natural waterway and the draining a wetland area has been further corrupted with what appears to be a wide application of devastating herbicides. Enforcement is non-existence in our area and I need help finding a way to stop ALL my neighbors from disregarding the NSA, required planning and reviews, all while the County's look the other way. County Assessors constantly document new construction, agricultural development and natural habitat destruction, but we who care have no way to stop it. Please ask the Commission on my behalf, to offer caring gorge residents and visitors, new ways to help protect these dwindling resources and stop the rampant destruction of our "protected" scenic area.
